## WHY DON'T YOU?

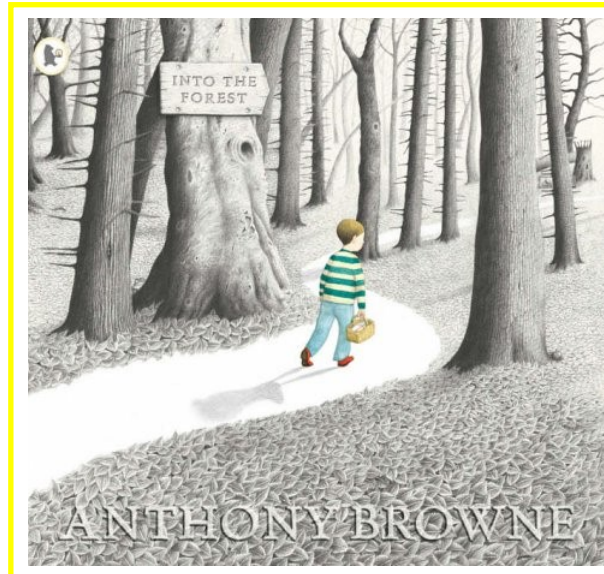
Here are some activities that you could complete with your child this term to continue their learning at home ..
