What will we be learning this term?

English

Quality Texts : 'Goldilocks and Just the One Bear'

Children will learn how to write a number of fiction and non-fiction genres. We will concentrate on basic sentence building including; punctuation, spelling and handwriting.

In reading children will focus on understanding parts of a text and learning about the use of vocabulary from different authors. They will also take part in drama and role play around their book.

Maths

This term, the main focus for children will be the development of their skills in number including money and calculation . For Year 2 this will include:

- Addition and subtraction problems with money, measure and number.
- Multiplication and division problem solving.
- Fractions of shape and number
- Time

Science

Enquiry Questions:

What do we need to make our body healthy and 'just right'?

Why can't Mowgli live in the jungle?

Both units are biology based and will be teaching the children about life cycles, the human body, health, exercise and adaptation.

R.E and SMSC

Enquiry question: What do signs and symbols mean?

During R.E we will be looking at the importance of signs and symbols including some religious symbols.

Computing

This half term children will learn how to use the internet safely.

Topic

Enquiry:

How does baby bear know he is in a city? (Manchester)

Our topic for the Autumn term is all about city life. Children will explore the history of our city; Manchester. We will also be studying Manchester's famous artist Lowry, looking at his work and painting replica pieces with an artist from the Lowry Centre. The geographical aspects of this unit will look at the differences between villages, towns and cities and children will be able to name some of the main cities of the UK.
