This term, the main focus for our children will be the

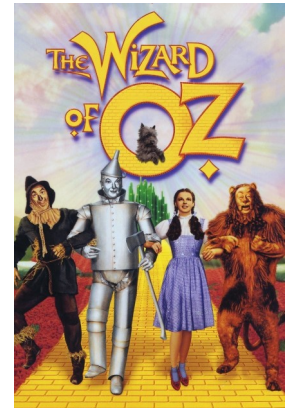
development of their skills in number, calculation, and also shape and measure work. For Year 5 this will include:
